

Link report for October 2011

Remembrance Day: A reminder for your diaries that the Annual Remembrance Sunday service on 13th November will be at St Mary's Church at 10.30 am.

The wreath laying service at the Memorial Clock is anticipated to start at 11:45am.

Bus Shelter: A replica of a plaque originally in the Memorial Bus Shelter adjoining the Village Hall, is being reinstalled in the original position. The Memorial Shelter will be re-dedicated as part of the wreath-laying service at the Memorial Clock.

Graffiti: We would like to ask those of a younger generation to remember that the bus shelter is in fact a War Memorial, and to refrain from leaving their mark on it. You may be a Banksy in the making, but please practise on the walls of you own bedrooms, and not around the village.

Good neighbours: Our surgery on the subject of Good Neighbours produced a positive response. As a result we intend to host an inaugural meeting on Saturday, 15th October, starting at 10:30 in the village hall.
